High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. Further to the Covid-19 restrictions being relaxed we are now beginning to plan for future face-to-face engagement events and meetings. Whilst we continue to move forward, we will continue to communicate with communities via letters, online meetings and phone calls. What are we doing?

Ahead of the main work construction of HS2 we need to create two bell mouth highway entrances, on the A361 and Byfield Road. The bell mouths will be constructed with a sealed surface entrance which will lead from the highway into the adjacent fields. To undertake these works safely, we will need to install two-way temporary traffic light controls at these locations.

We will additionally need to make repairs to the chevron signs on the A361 Chipping Warden Relief Road roundabout and install two vehicle activated signs, advising motorists of their speed on A361 Banbury Road.

Byfield Road

The bell mouth works will commence on 22 July until 24 August 2022 (subject to local authority consents)

The two- way temporary traffic lights on Byfield Road will be operational off-peak hours during school term time, Monday to Friday from 09.30am to 3pm.

The two – way temporary lights, out of school term time will be operational Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm.

To install the signs, we will require two-way temporary traffic lights on the A361Banbury Road, Monday to Friday from 08:00am to 5pm.

A361 Chipping Warden Relief Road roundabout (chevron sign repairs)

Works will take place from the **18 July to 22 July 2022 (subject to local authority consents).**

To undertake the repairs to the chevron signs, we will require two-way temporary traffic lights on the A361Chipping Warden Relief Road roundabout, Monday to Friday from 08:00am to 5pm.

A361 Chipping Warden Relief Road

The bell mouth work on the A361 Chipping Warden Relief Road will commence on **5 August until 7 September 2022 (subject to local authority consents).**

Two-way temporary traffic lights on the A361 Chipping Warden Relief Road will be operational Monday to Friday from 08:00am to 5pm.

Welsh Road - (ditching maintenance works)

Works will commence on **8 August until 19 August 2022** (**subject to local authority consents**)

To enable us to carry out remedial and maintenance works to the existing highway ditch on Welsh Road, we will require four way temporary traffic lights. Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm
