The Parish Council followed the National mourning protocol, a book of condolences was made available to all village residents. The Proclamation was read by the Chairman (CL).

Historical records held by the Parish Council since 1894 were handed into the Northamptonshire Records Office for archival heritage.

The Chairman (CL) announced his intentions to stand down as Chairman and as a Councillor at the May 2023 AGM after serving the Parish Council for the past 15 years.


